



# Artist Report

**Objective:** Student will create a report about the life and work of a famous fine artist.

**Materials:** At least two pieces of lined paper, one blank sheet of paper, three resources (outlined below), computer access.

**Method:**

- a) Student decides which artist they would like to do their report about.
- b) Student collects at least three research resources. They are:
  - A biographical resource
  - An art history resource
  - An internet resource
- c) Student writes the report. The report is to be at least three pages long (using both sides of the paper). It is to be **hand written (LEGIBLY or it will not be accepted), in pen.** The fourth page is to contain a bibliography.

**Cover-** The cover of the report may be typed for the purpose of a pleasing presentation. It is to have a picture on it, either of the artist or one of his works. The artist's name shall serve as the title of the report. The following information shall also be included:

**For:** eighth grade pd. X

**Instructor:** Mr. Andrews

**Month Day, Year**

**Contents of the report:** The report will contain a great deal of information. The student will likely find it difficult to keep it to three pages. He is welcome to write more, of course. Every submission should contain information about the artist's life (the basics), what medium or media he worked in, what style he worked in (and a brief background of that style) and it should also contain discussions of at least two of the artist's major works.
